

PROJECT GREEN SWEEP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

I. Generator Information

Business/Organization Name: Indicate the legal name of the business or organization.

Contact Person: List the information for the primary contact person that will have knowledge of the type and volumes of waste materials that the business or organization generates.

Addresses: List both the mailing and physical address for the primary office of the business/organization. If there are multiple locations please provide the addresses for all participating locations under that business/organization name. Generator status may require that there be separate applications for each location. That will be determined by *Project Green Sweep* staff as part of the screening process.

EPA Number: The waste activities and generator status of the business/organization may require reporting those waste activities to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and receiving a unique identification number. Please list the EPA Identification Number if a number has been assigned to the business/organization.

Type of Business: Please select the type of business operation that best applies to the activities conducted by the business/organization. If none of the pre-listed types apply, select other and list the business type in the blank.

II. Generator Status

CESQG: Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator. To meet this requirement your business cannot generate more than 100 kilograms (220 lbs) of hazardous waste or more than 1 kilogram of an acute hazardous waste in any calendar month.

SQG: Small Quantity Generator. A small quantity generator generates more than 220 pounds but less than 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste **AND** no more than 2.2 pounds of acute hazardous waste in any calendar month. SQG's can only use *Project Green Sweep* to dispose of universal or other regulated wastes that are not determined to be hazardous by environmental regulations. According to environmental regulations, SQG waste that is determined to be hazardous must deal directly with a permitted and licensed treatment, storage, or disposal company.

LQG: Large Quantity Generator. A large quantity generator generates at least 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste or more than 2.2 pounds of acute hazardous waste in any calendar month. LQG's can only use *Project Green Sweep* to dispose of universal or other regulated wastes that are not determined to be hazardous by environmental regulations. According to environmental regulations LQG waste that is determined to be hazardous must deal directly with a permitted and licensed treatment, storage, or disposal company.

Universal Waste Under certain conditions batteries, pesticides, mercury thermostats, and lamps qualify as a universal waste and not a hazardous waste.

Other Regulated Waste These are materials that may not qualify as hazardous or universal wastes but are otherwise banned from landfill disposal in Sarasota County. Some of these materials include electronics, oil, oil filters, and latex paints.

III. Certification

The person that is authorized to represent the business organization must read the certification statement and complete the signature portion of the form.
