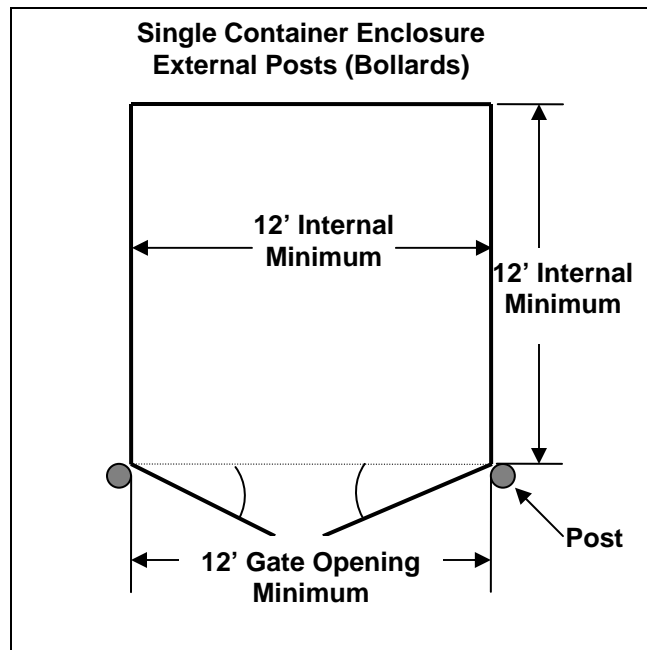
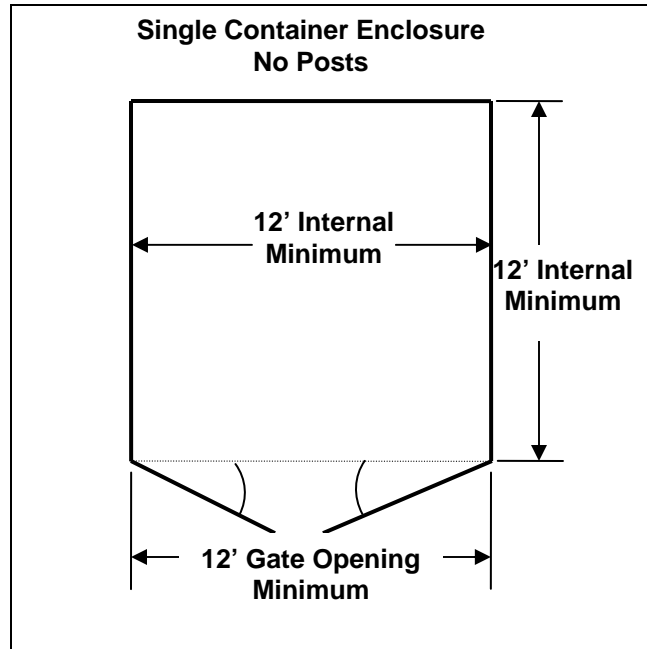
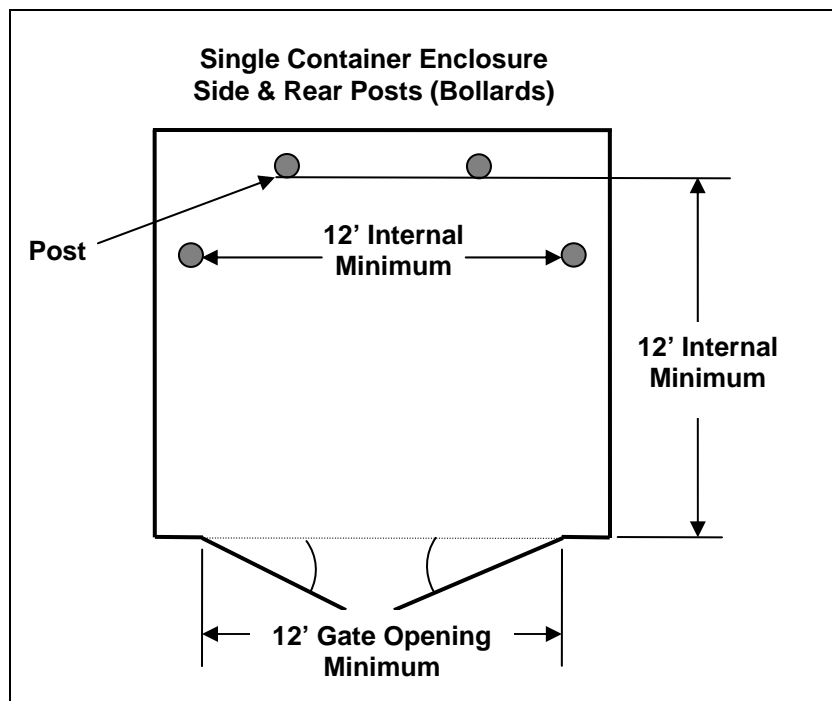
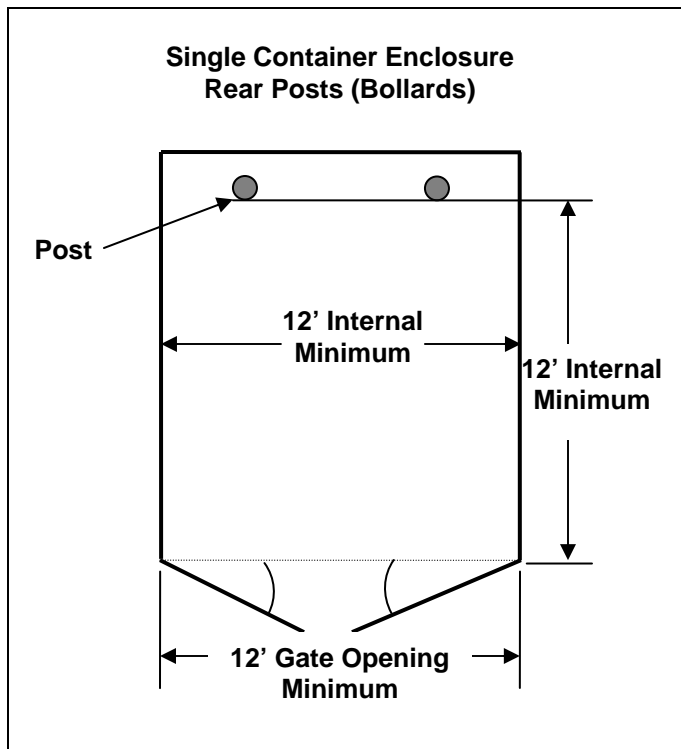


Sarasota County Ordinance 2003-092 – Enclosure Dimensions Requirements

These dimensional sketches are applicable to minimum enclosure requirements. Enclosures are required to be of sufficient size to enclose all garbage and recycling containers. Multiple enclosures meeting the minimum dimension requirements may be used where space limitations do not allow the construction of a single enclosure large enough to accommodate necessary garbage and recycling containers.



Gates are required on all solid waste/recycling container enclosures. Enclosure openings are required to be a minimum of 12' wide. Gates must be equipped with a device to hold them in an open position and should open at least 90 degrees. Safety posts (bollards) are not a requirement of this ordinance. However, if safety posts (bollards) are installed, measurements must be made from the inside face of the posts to the inside front of the enclosure as shown above.



Safety posts (bollards) are not a requirement of this ordinance. However, installing safety posts (bollards) inside the enclosure changes how the minimum dimensions of the enclosure should be measured. As shown above, all measurements are made within the perimeter of the rear and/or side posts (bollards).
