Sarasota County Administrator James Ley has been elected to the board of the LeRoy Collins Institute at Florida State University.

The LeRoy Collins Institute is the independent, non-partisan organization that studies and promotes creative solutions to key private and public issues facing the people of Florida and the nation. The institute currently is examining state-local governmental relationships in Florida.

The board is composed of 22 public and private sector representatives from throughout the state. Ley will serve with two other local board members: John McKay, former state Senate president; and Mike Michalson, president of New College of Florida.
