“Law at the Library” series returns to Selby Public Library

The Sarasota County Library System is bringing back one of its most popular education programs, “Law at the Library,” with events happening from January until May. The popular events are the result of a partnership between Selby Public Library and the Young Lawyers Division of the Sarasota County Bar Association.

The first session is on January 26 and is titled “Take this job and ... wait, what do I do now?” will cover various unemployment issues including filing for unemployment, appeal hearings, wrongful termination, employment discrimination, continuation of health insurance and retirement packages. The program will also provide tips on filling out a job application, how to prepare for an interview and a general idea of what an employer can and cannot ask you.
