## **Landlord and tenant issues are the topic at ‘Law at the Library’ program**

Selby Public Library continues its partnership with the Young Lawyers Division of the Sarasota County Bar Association in offering the third annual “Law at the Library” series, 6 p.m. Monday, March 30, at Selby Public Library, 1331 First St., Sarasota.

The upcoming session, “You’re outta here! Common issues in landlord/tenant disputes and evictions,” will offer helpful hints on dealing with a variety of landlord/tenant issues pertinent to both parties.

Florida law provides a defined framework for settling disputes between landlords and tenants. The panel of experts includes Kevin R.
