‘Hope for Homeowners’ foreclosure seminar set for Oct. 3

Sarasota County homeowners who need help with foreclosures, bankruptcy, credit problems or home ownership opportunities can attend a free “Hope for Homeowners” seminar from 9 a.m.- 2 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 3, at the Boys and Girls Club of Sarasota, 3100 Fruitville Road, Sarasota.

Chief Judge Lee Haworth of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit Court of Florida will lead a panel discussion and discuss what the courts are doing to protect homeowners facing foreclosure.
