It's time to empty the closets and garage, clean off the lanai and gather up stray brush. Sarasota County will hold its annual community cleanup day from 8 a.m.-3 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 24, for the South Venice community.

Dumpsters provided by Waste Management will be available at three locations to receive materials from residents:

- 720 Alligator Drive (South Venice Community Center)
- 2000 block Lemon Bay Drive (South Venice ferry landing)
- Seaboard Drive near Orange Street

Residents can dispose of most appliances, household items, scrap materials, unbundled yard waste, and other materials during this free event. Sarasota County employees will be available at each site to offer assistance.

Paint, pesticides, auto parts, televisions, computers, and other hazardous materials will not be accepted.
