Sarasota County hosts Lime Lake neighborhood improvement meeting

Lime Lake neighborhood residents are invited to a meeting to gather community ideas about how to improve conditions around the lake. The meeting will be at 6 p.m., Tuesday, July 28 at Newtown Estates Recreation Center, 2800 Newtown Blvd., Sarasota. Lime Lake is south of Emma Booker Elementary School.

Officials from Sarasota County Parks and Recreation in partnership with the North Sarasota Neighborhood Association will host the session. Staff from Sarasota County Neighborhood Services, Transportation Planning, Stormwater and the Sarasota County School Board also will attend.

The neighborhood meeting is the next step following a brainstorming session with neighborhood residents led by Euline Myrick hosted by Sarasota County Parks and Recreation General Manager John McCarthy.

"It was a great meeting where we talked about the issues surrounding the lake and how we move forward to address them," McCarthy said. "One of the first things we have to do is engage the community to find out what they want to see at Lime Lake."
