Sarasota County has openings in Civics 101 program

Sarasota County government's popular Civics 101 program still has openings for the session beginning Sept. 2.

Civics 101 is an introduction to the operations and services of Sarasota County government. During the 10-week program, staff from county departments guide participants through numerous operational areas, explaining how the county develops policies and provides programs and services. The classes help participants understand county government and create relationships with county staff.

Sessions are offered in the spring and fall each year. Twenty-five people are selected each term on a first-come, first-served basis.
