## **South county community cleanup will be held Oct. 23**

It's time to clean out the garage and gather up yard waste and discarded household items. Sarasota County will hold its annual free community cleanup in the south county area from 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 23.

Dumpsters will be provided by Waste Management at three South Venice locations:

- South Venice Community Center, 720 Alligator Drive
- Seaboard Drive near Orange Street
- South Venice ferry landing, 2000 block of Lemon Bay Drive

Residents can dispose of most appliances, household items, scrap materials, unbundled yard waste and other garbage or refuse. Sarasota County employees will be available at each site to offer assistance.

Hazardous waste such as paint, pesticides, auto parts, electronic devices, televisions and computers may be discarded from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Wednesday-Saturday at the Sarasota County Chemical Collection Center, 8750 Bee Ridge Road, Sarasota.
